- Recommendation and Records** – Please provide copies of your child’s report cards for the last two years. In addition, we will need two letters of recommendation for each applicant. We have enclosed a form that may be used. Recommendation letters must be sent directly from the current school or be in a sealed envelope. It can also be faxed to the Admissions Office at 954-472-3088. At this time the Admissions Department will call your child’s school to verify attendance and discipline record.
- Student Application** – All students entering Grades 6 – 12 should complete the Student Application and return it with his/her application **one week prior to testing**.
- Testing** – The Admissions Department requires ability and/or readiness evaluations for all applicants. To schedule a test, please call extension 3062. The fee for testing is \$100.00. The application, records, recommendations, and student application are due **one week prior to testing**.

The **Admissions Department** will review the application after all materials are received and all procedures are completed.

When an applicant is accepted for admission, the parents will receive an enrollment contract. In order to secure a place, the contract must be executed and the appropriate deposit made.
